Decision

1. The player Rodolfo Alves de Melo (date of birth: 19 March 1991) is sanctioned worldwide with a provisional suspension as of 11 July 2019 until a decision is passed on the disciplinary proceedings opened against him on the grounds of doping. This sanction covers the participation, in any capacity, in a competition or activity (other than authorised anti-doping education or rehabilitation programmes) authorised or organised by FIFA or any association, a club or other member organisation of an association, or in competitions authorised or organised by any professional league or any international or national-level competition organisation or any elite or national-level sporting activity funded by a governmental agency.
2. This decision will follow the outcome of any possible appeal lodged against the decision passed by the Disciplinary Committee of the CONMEBOL as long as the decision on appeal complies with the regulations of FIFA.

Note relating to the terms of the decision:

The judicial bodies may decide not to communicate the grounds of a decision and instead communicate only the terms of the decision. The parties have ten days from receipt of the terms of the decision to request, in writing, the grounds of the decision, and that failure to do so will result in the decision becoming final and binding (art. 51 of the FIFA Disciplinary Code (FDC)).
